

## 2021 Stability & Expansion Goals

This year our priority was to expand the engineering team and the rebuild the Gurbani Media Center website that users access from web browsers.



# Goal #1: Establish Engineering Team

Over the years a lot of technical debt has been building to the point where updating our applications and deploying new services has become a large scale project.

With a set of processes and leveraging automated deployment we will be able to be agile and get feedback on bugs and issues earlier on in the process.

#### SUCCESS:

Hired on resources and a new CTO to provide guidance.

#### PROGRESS:

- Interm PT CTO Jujhar Singh to provide guidance as we deliver well architected, properly built and sustainable products and services
- FT lead developer, Manraj Singh is joined by FT developer Kiranpreet Singh focused on frontend & mobile development
- PT developer Matilde focused on backend engineering

# Goal #2: New Modern Website for Gurbani Media Center

Rebuilding the Gurbani Media Center website that users access from web browsers. This accounts for the majority of SikhNet's web traffic that accesses both on mobile and desktop browsers.

**SUCCESS:** GMC Website that looks and functions like the mobile apps.

#### PROGRESS:

- Wireframes developed with the assistance of a design company
- Consistent and flexible design to work across desktop, tablet and mobile using a unified design language
- 75% of the backend infrastructure has been setup including the ability to render a page using configuration
- 30% of the main pages have been implemented including the Homepage and Artist pages

### Over 11,500 students are enrolled in SikhNet Learning Center courses.

In 2021, we launched one new course and continued open enrollment in our other 4 courses where we continue to provide support to active students.



Our latest course is *How to Meditate: Discover the Life*Changing Power of Naam Meditation and is offered in partnership with Nanak Naam.

This course focuses on:

- Sharing Guru Nanak Dev Ji's teachings in a way that's accessible to all
- Learning basic meditation techniques
- Developing a daily practice for greater peace and less stress
- How to deal with negative thoughts
